



It is important to clean mats regularly for several reasons amongst them being:

- To prevent the build up of bacteria on and under the mats
- To prevent the build up fats and oils on the matting
- To not attract vermin such as cockroaches
- To meet health department cleanliness standards

When cleaning the mats please bear the following in mind:

- High pressure hoses may be used if desired
- Use a neutral detergent and hot water to clean the mats
- Clean the floor under the mats as well
- Clean both the top and the bottom of mats
- Do not hang mats over railings or wash lines.
- To roll the mats up, roll them with the top side out
- Let mats dry thoroughly as this helps kill certain bacteria
